Some of the points made:

- 3. Hirons and H-T Interactive Media are both available to do extensive work that could cost 100's or even 1,000's of dollars.
- 4. Library science grad students will often do non-profit design for class projects.
- 5. Help could probably come from our own neighborhood association members
- 6. The City of Bloomington is making some changes to their websites, department by department.

The committee basically wants the CONA website to serve as a host to possible websites for our neighborhood associations. The committee has much to think about as we try to put dollars with our desired website and its contents.
