Minutes of the March 22nd meeting were approved.

1. The Financial Report was given by Nancy Flynn-Hert due to Jan Bulla-Bakers absence, The total \$2845.31 with no outstanding bills. And it was stated that the release of funds from HAND were available as of 4/19/2000 in the amount of \$2500.00
2. Bill Sturbaum gave a reminder of the need for membership assesment and applications on file. Extra applications were available.
3. Bill Sturbaum introduced a letter to Wal-Mart about the condition of there area and ask the Board to approve the submission of the letter to be sent to Wal-Mart and all other businesses that were negligent in the upkeep of their properties. This was approved by the Board and it was also suggested by Marjorie Hudgins that a letter of compliment be sent to businesses that maintained their properties.
4. It was ask that any known corrections be made to the current neighborhood contact list. Those known were noted for correction.
5. Report of April 3rd NAG meeting was given by Bill Sturbaum and Bill Boese. The primary focus was the eventual power of HAND to ticket for trash and weeds at unkempt properties. Also noted that Bill Sturbaum gets many of his agenda notes from the NAG meeting. The City Council will be hearing on the ticketing soon.
