The *Hand in Hand* program provides food to Monroe County residents and, at the same time, is an opportunity for Stone Belt client volunteers to engage in meaningful volunteer work in the community.

Question: How does the *Hand in Hand* program work?

**Answer: It's EASY!** Neighborhoods are assigned a weekly date; Stone Belt clients (with staff) collect non-perishable food donations and deliver them to Community Kitchen. Donors place their contributions in special bags outside their homes. Stone Belt leaves an empty bag for the following pick up date.
