



# HOW TO APPLY

# CONTACT

Contact your local SWCD office to discuss your project and set up a site visit.

# SITE VISIT

Experienced SWCD staff collaborating on the project will provide technical assistance to each interested landowner by writing a detailed Landowner Invasive Plant Assessment.

# **APPLICATION**

Applications will be accepted year-round and will be ranked and approved by SWCD staff and their Board of Supervisors on a quarterly basis per each year of CWI funding (2017–2019).

# FINAL INSPECTION

Technical staff will visit site to check for project completeness.

# REIMBURSMENT

After final inspection, landowners will turn in receipts to SWCD staff. Reimbursements will cover 75% of costs, not to exceed the per acre rate for invasive species removal and \$500 for native planting.
